SEC. 2. PROHIBITING USE OF FUNDS FOR NEW PERMA-
NENT FENCING AROUND UNITED STATES
CAPITOL.
(a) IN GENERAL.—No Federal funds may be used
to install new permanent fencing around—
(1) the perimeter of any of the Capitol Build-
ings described in section 5101 of title 40, United
States Code; or
(2) the perimeter of the United States Capitol
Grounds, or any portion thereof, described in section
5102 of such title.
(b) Repair and Replacement of Existing Fenc-
ING.—Nothing in subsection (a) shall be construed to pro-
hibit the repair or replacement of fencing that was in ex-
istence on the date of enactment of this Act around an
area described in subsection (a).
